History

Colegio Leffler, also known as the Leffler International Olympic School, was founded in 2020 by long term Bahian Educators Luciene Bastos and Humberto Prates.

For the last 25 years, as leaders of Curso Interseção, Luciene and Humberto ran the most successful post graduate prep courses for Brazil's most competitive exams: IME, ITA, FUVEST, UNICAMP and ENEM. Their course was and is the only program to regularly approve Bahian students into Brazil's prestigious military academies, IME and ITA. While providing the PG course, they also coordinated an Olympiad prep track for High School students that provided a more diverse, complete and rigorous curriculum as well as additional preparation courses for International Leadership Programs, Summer Programs, Academic Olympiads, **Essay Competitions**

Mission

Leffler was founded with the mission to provide high school education those same students with more care in a smaller, more supportive atmosphere with reduced class sizes and augmented class hours complemented by a variety of extracurricular activities, principally in STEAM. All students have access to specialty classes on the most diverse topics, including those concentrating on the Brazilian Physics, Chemistry, Brazilian National History and many other Olympiads in which Leffler's students won medals at the nationals in both operating years.

The school aims to promote a global outlook with additional advanced language classes and opportunities for international exchanges and educational events. Amongst many others, these events include the Harvard MUN competition, in which students had an outstanding performance recognized by the university. In addition, we also encourage and support essay competitions as a mean to students develop their writing and critical thinking. Some of the examples of Leffler's students participating in said activities are France's YPE competition promoted by the Ecole Jeaninne Manuel, in which a Leffler student placed 2nd with an essay recognized by the former French President Nicolas Sarkozy, and the Harvard Crimson Global Essay Competition.

Above all, Leffler is a place where students are often encouraged to go beyond their own expectations and get in direct touch with the directors, coordinators and counselors to propose their own educational projects, aiming to improve the diversity on education, which has been extremely effective in helping develop new skills for students. In this vein, the school aims to provide every possible resource to meet the students proposed educational projects.

Located in Salvador, the capital of Afro-Brazilian culture, we leverage our location and our diverse student body (roughly 40% of our student body self-defines as black or mixed race) to offer unique interdisciplinary humanities and current events workshops, and encourage our students political activity in the city, state and on the national stage with participation in the National Youth Parliament Competition, and the esteemed pride of our students that organized the First MUN competition for Public Schools in our state.

COVID Impact Statement:

Coronavirus hit Brazil a few weeks into the start of our first school year. Students and staff had to adjust to virtual learning, shifts in the calendar (with canceled holidays and rescheduled vacations) and delayed exams (with seniors still in classes through mid-February), all while implementing new curriculum, building new bonds, and establishing new expectations for the school. All this process was also intensified due to unstable internet connections in the northeast of the Brazilian national territory

We are proud to have built a strong community and supported our students in accomplishing many goals and earning many national/international awards despite these challenges. We were able to provide Chromebooks to all students that required an access to virtual learning tools, especially to our scholarship students, in addition to extra tutoring sessions, so all students didn't fall behind. Under guidance of psychologists, we transitioned to recorded to live classes and meetings to supplement and better support our students, but all classes were kept available to students that had difficulties to participating live, with also a full 24/7 support for students to ask questions regarding school subjects through the "insert name" platform.

The return to mixed classes (both online and in-person) happened on May 4th, following all the protocols established by both national and international Health Organizations and a full vaccinated staff. On September 23th our classes migrated to full in-person classes following the same protocols established with additional class sessions to prepare students for university exams and offset any gaps.
